BIOLOGY ECOLOGY TRIP TO GILBERT WHITE'S HOUSE ON MONDAY 13 MAY 2024

GCSE Biology content – Ecology required practical.

Pupils in Year 9 and Year 10 are due to go Gilbert White's House, Selbourne, to take part in an AQA required GCSE Biology practical. They will be conducting field investigations to estimate Biodiversity in a variety of locations. Biodiversity is difficult to assess in its natural habitat so pupils will be carrying out an investigation that allows this to be estimated.

There are two parts to this investigation:

- 1. Measuring the population size using random sampling
- 2. Investigating the effect of a factor on that plant's distribution using a transect line

Whilst on site, pupils will working in The Meadow (systematic sampling) and Bakers Hill (random sampling); Bakers Hill is the grassy slope down from the statue of Gilbert White.




