Earth Science and Engineering (ESE) Taster Day – Wed 10 July 2024, Royal School of Mines, Imperial College London

The ESE Taster Day is a chance for pupils in Y11 and Y12 primarily to come to the <u>Royal School of Mines</u> in South Kensington, and experience a day in the life of our undergraduates, showcasing the exciting research and teaching they do in Earth Science and Engineering.

This includes interactive workshops and research talks on topical Earth Science subjects - such as climate change, the energy transition and sustainable resources, and the application of technology to solving global challenges – as well as core geoscience topics such as geohazards and fossils.

There is also the chance to see their facilities in South Kensington, and chat with current students and staff. The day is free of charge, lunch is provided, and some travel bursaries are available.
